#### NOTES

3. THR 151 may be taken out of sequence (151, 150); THR 150 will always be offered in the fall semester.
4. Students should see the Faculty Advisors during their Freshman year to plan upper division studies.
5. Upper division studies are organized in "units"; see GMU Catalog and advisor.
6. THR majors may complete Minor or Foreign Language requirement.

7. Total of 24 upper level THR credits required. THR synthesis credits may count towards this total. Upper level THR courses taken to complete Theater Core requirements do NOT count towards this total.
